The name of the dog and all the details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of the Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club and if a registered dog has changed ownership the TRANSFER must be registered before the date of the Show. Puppies under 6 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. For new registrations the first choice name on the Registration Application form should be used. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.

Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations are to be read in conjunction with the Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
 2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
 3. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows.
 4. Not for competition entries are not accepted.
 5. Entries may not be made via the internet.
 6. Members classes - Not applicable
 7. The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
 8. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped, addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
 9. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (9am) after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management
 10. Timed stays - Not applicable.
 11. For the duration of the show all dogs, including those in the exercise area, must be on a lead except when competing or practising prior to competition.
 12. Animals allowed in Event.
No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
 13. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the Show if it is:-
 - (a) A bitch, which is in season.
 - (b) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - (c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - (d) Of such temperament or so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - (e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
 14. Dogs will be disqualified if proved to have been handled by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
 15. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
 16. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
 17. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
 18. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
 19. No prize money is on offer at this show.
 20. All offers of sponsorship or donation will be included in the Schedule/Catalogue with the name of the sponsors.
 21. Use of cooking stoves is forbidden.
 22. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS**
Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.
If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
 23. Welfare of dogs
A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
 24. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is strictly forbidden.
 25. No dog shall be allowed in the judging ring other than those competing in the class being judged.
 26. Nothing may be carried, worn or displayed by a handler or a dog during judging which is capable of indicating the identity of the dog or owner nor must anything be said or any action taken which identifies the dog, other than by exhibit number.
 27. Any dog which is not presented for stay or scent exercises when called for testing will be considered to have withdrawn from the class.
 28. Food shall not be carried or given to a dog under test.
 29. After commencement of judging the responsibility for dogs being brought to the ring to compete is entirely the competitors.
 30. The maximum number of entries allowed in any class is 60.
 31. Once a dog has commenced competing in a Class, no substitution of handler is permitted in that Class.
 32. The Show will open at 8.30 am
Judging will commence at 9.00 am Sharp.
The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.

Definitions of Classes

- 1 In the following definitions of classes First prize wins in Limited and Sanction Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Show Obedience Classes but do count for eligibility at Limited Obedience Shows or Open Shows confined to one breed.
- 2 A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another standard class if desired, plus one additional special class if scheduled.
- 3 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the closing date for entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 04th February 2012.

BEGINNERS	To compete in Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more First Prizes in Beginners Class, or one First Prize in any other Obedience Class. (Pre-Beginners excepted).
NOVICE	For dogs that have not won two First Prizes in Obedience Classes (Pre-Beginners and Beginners excepted).
CLASS A	For dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.
CLASS B	For dogs, which have not won three First Prizes in Class B and Open C in total.
OPEN CLASS C	At Open Shows, and in the Open C Classes held at Championship Shows, Open to all dogs.
