ENTRY FEES:

€5 per dog per class **OR** UNLIMITED ENTRIES:

First dog: €17 per dog per day

Second and subsequent dogs € 8 per dog per day

**MAXIMUM ENTRY FEE €65 per exhibitor
for any number of dogs, over two days.**

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. Warm up jumps and exercise area will be available for competitors. No practice will be allowed on agility equipment in the competition ring prior to competition. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the show will lead to automatic disqualification.
2. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility tests.
4. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
5. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class.
6. No bitch in season to be present at show.
7. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
8. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close-fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar, i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
13. **NO e-mail entries will be accepted. Entries will only be accepted when received on official entry form (or photocopy) complete with correct payment.**
14. **Each dog's registration number and Grade MUST be given on the entry form, otherwise the entry will be returned.**
15. **All competitors must show respect for the judge. Training rounds will only be allowed if prior permission has been given by the judge.**

AGILITY GRADING SYSTEM

GRADE 1 (Elementary)

For handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. *N.B. Handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

GRADE 2 (Introductory)

For handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

GRADE 3 (Preliminary)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

GRADE 4 (Novice – No Wins)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

GRADE 5 (Novice – 2 wins or over)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

GRADE 6 (Open)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

GRADE 7 (Premier)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

ABC

Open to all dogs except collies or collie-crosses. The judge will have the final decision on whether or not to accept any entrant in these classes. Height of jumps will be as for Large Dog Classes, i.e. between 550mm–650mm (1ft 9ins–2ft 1.6 ins.)

HEATS: Rosettes will be presented for 1st–4th places each day in Agility Heats, but scores will be brought forward from Heat 1 to Heat 2, with the overall winner being presented with the **Victor Corbally Memorial Trophy** (Grades 6–7 Large Dog Agility), **K9 Arc Perpetual Trophy** (Grades 1–5 Large Dog Agility), **Jaffin Perpetual Trophy** (Grades 3–7 Small Dog Agility) or Framed Photo of your dog (courtesy of **Black Blur Photography**) for winners of Grades 1–2 Large, Medium and Small Dog Agility.

TEAMS: Each team will consist of three or four dogs, with the three best scores to count. Competitors who wish to enter the team events should enter the relevant classes on the entry form. Nominated COMPLETE teams may be submitted, other competitors will be assigned to a team by a draw which will take place in advance of the competition. Team competitors MUST be available for both days, as NO SUBSTITUTIONS will be permitted. Each dog may compete on one agility team and one jumping team, but no dog may compete on two different agility or jumping teams, nor may any dog run twice in the same competition.

PAIRS: As for team events above, except that as there are only two dogs on each team, both scores will count in every round.

DECLARATION, UNDERTAKING AND AGREEMENT BY EXHIBITOR

1. I HEREBY DECLARE that the dog, dogs or litters entered by me above are REGISTERED in my name, with the Irish Kennel Club.
2. I HEREBY DECLARE that the dog, or dogs entered by me as above are not vicious, and are bona-fide my property, and I enter them subject to the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and the Regulations of the Show, which appear in the Schedule and which I have read.
3. I HEREBY UNDERTAKE not to bring within the precincts of the Show any dog which (1) has distemper or other communicable disease; (2) has had distemper or other communicable disease unless he has been fully recovered for more than 30 days immediately prior to the show, or (3) has been in contact with or in any kennels or establishment containing distemper or other communicable disease during the 30 days immediately prior to the Show, or (4) has been inoculated with Distemper Virus or displayed any reaction therefrom during the 30 days immediately prior to the Show, or (5) has been in contact during the 30 days immediately prior to the Show with any dog which was previously inoculated with Distemper Virus within 30 days.
4. IN CONSIDERATION of my entry being accepted I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the Irish Kennel Club and/or its Trustees or its Officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatever source arising caused by or to any dog exhibited by me while in the precincts of the Show; (2) that any decision given concerning me by the Irish Kennel Club or by any Committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this Show, shall be communicated by the Secretary of the Irish Kennel Club to all whom at the sole discretion of the Irish Kennel Club, it may concern and that such a decision, together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name and address and description.
5. I HEREBY UNDERTAKE to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club and of the Show.
6. I UNDERTAKE to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as competitor in the Show.
