RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Working Trial will be held under the Licence, Rules and Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
2. The Working Trial will be held at Painestown, Co. Meath.
3. The entry fee will be €14 for UD and WD stakes. Cheques etc. to be made payable to Fingal Dog Club.
4. In the event of any of the first four places not being awarded in any stake, Fingal Dog Club may award Special place rosettes.
5. Entries to be received by Sunday 29th January 2012.
6. Fingal Dog Club reserves the right to refuse any entry.
7. Dogs must be over 6 months of age on the first day of the Working Trial to enter. However, only dogs over 18 months of age (on the first day of the working trial) are eligible to participate in the Agility section.
8. All dogs must be registered or transferred with the I.K.C. Ltd., save in the case of greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club.
9. All competitors will be notified of their report times by e-mail/in writing at least two weeks before the trial.
10. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
11. No bitches in season are allowed to compete at the trial or be present on the land.
12. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the trial is forbidden.
13. Competitors are requested not to train or practice on the tracking grounds and adjacent land, otherwise our permission to hold the trial in the locality could be withdrawn.
14. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their report time.
15. The Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute Judge if circumstances prevent an appointed judge fulfilling his appointment.
16. Should circumstances so dictate the Club, in consultation with the Judge may alter arrangements as necessary.
17. Fingal Dog Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accidents by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the trial.

RULES AND REGULATIONS (cont.)

18. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at the Trial, and any such behaviour must be penalised by disqualification.
