DIRECTIONS TO VENUE:

From M1/Belfast: Exit the M1 at junction 1 (Junction with M50), then at roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the M50 (signposted Other Routes, Southbound) Exit the M50 at junction 9 to follow signs Limerick onto the N7. Exit the M7 at junction 11, then join the M9 motorway (signposted Waterford, Kilkenny, Carlow). Take the Kilcullen exit, at T junction turn right (signposted Kilcullen/Athy Castlecomer) Stay on the N78 for approx 16 kms. Pass a Small garden centre on the right ,Forest Farm approx 200mtrs on left hand side.

From M50:

Exit the M50 at junction 9 to follow signs Limerick onto the N7. Exit the M7 at junction 11, then join the M9 motorway (signposted Waterford, Kilkenny, Carlow). Take the Kilcullen exit, at T junction turn right (signposted Kilcullen/Athy Castlecomer) Stay on the N78 for approx 16 kms. Pass a Small garden centre on the right ,Forest Farm approx 200mtrs on left hand side.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility classes.
3. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
4. No bitch in season to be present at show.
5. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
6. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dogs are kept under proper control at all times.
7. Flat collars only to be worn while competing in agility tests.
8. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
9. No practising with dogs in competition area prior to tests will be allowed. To do so merits disqualification.
10. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
11. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
12. The show will be held under the Rules and Regulations of the Irish Agility & Dog Sports Association. All dogs & handlers entered for competition must be registered with the Irish Agility & Dog Sports Association
13. Should the appointed Judge be unable to fulfil their appointment the committee reserve the right to appoint another Judge.
14. Should circumstances so dictate the association or club, in consultation with the Judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Irish Agility and Dog Sports Association.
15. There will be a vet on call.

DECLARATION, UNDERTAKING AND AGREEMENT BY OWNER OR AGENT

- 1.I hereby declare that the dog/dogs entered by me as above are not vicious, and are bona-fide my property, and I enter them subject to the rules and the Regulations of the Show which appear in the schedule and which I have read.
- 2.I hereby undertake not to bring within the precincts of the show any dog which has (a) distemper or other communicable disease, unless it has been fully recovered for more than 30 days immediately prior to the show or (b) has been in contact with or in any kennel or establishment containing distemper or any other communicable disease during 30 days immediately prior to the show or (c) has been inoculated with distemper virus or displayed any reaction there from during the 30 days immediately prior to the show or (d) has been in contact during the 30 days immediately prior to the show with any dog which was previously inoculated with distemper within 30 days.
- 3.In consideration of my entry being accepted, I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the IADSA and/or its trustees or officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatsoever source arising, caused by, or to any dogs exhibited by me while in the precincts of the show and (2) that any decision given concerning me by the IADSA or by any committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this show shall be communicated by the secretary of the IADSA. To all whom it may concern, and that any such decision together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name, address and description.
- 4.I hereby undertake to abide by the rules and regulations of the IADSA and of its show.
- 5.I undertake to indemnify the promoters against any claims arising out of my participation as a competitor in the show.
