AGILITY GRADING SYSTEM	
Grade 1	For handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at IADSA licensed Agility Shows. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class</i>
Grade 2	For handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class</i>
Grade 3	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4,5,6, or 7.
Grade 4	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5,6 or 7
Grade 5	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4 , 6 or 7.
Grade 6	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 or elected to progress on points from Grade 5 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5, or 7.
Grade 7	Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
Note	<p><u>NEW MEMBERS:</u></p> <p>Only your current grade up to grade 5 can be transferred from IKC & KC. Progression points cannot be transferred from IKC or KC. If you wish to progress on points you start with your current grade & zero (0) points.</p>

Dogs from Northern Ireland or the UK

Dogs that compete under KC /IKC Regulations should enter

The grade equivalent to the grade they work in their own country

All dogs must be registered with the IADSA.

Owners/Handlers must bring to the show their agility record books

Containing the officially recorded height of their dogs.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR DOGS UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES AND PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. Warm up jumps and exercise area may be available for competitors.
No practice will be allowed on agility equipment in the competition ring prior to competition.
Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the show will lead to automatic disqualification.
2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter.
4. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
5. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class. Running order will be posted ring side on the day.
6. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.
7. The mating of bitches within the precinct of the show-ground is forbidden.
8. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judge's discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to commencement of the test.
13. No e-mail entries will be accepted. Entries will only be accepted when received on official entry form (or photocopy) complete with correct payment.
14. Each dog's registration number MUST be given on the entry form, otherwise the entry will be returned.
15. All competitors must show respect for the judge. Training rounds will only be allowed if prior permission has been given by the judge.
16. MWDTC will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accidents by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
17. Exhibitors must clean up if their dogs foul the grounds. Suitable facilities will be provided for this.
18. The Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute Judge if circumstances prevent an appointed Judge from fulfilling the appointment.
19. Height of Jumps – as per IADSA Rules & Regulations..
20. Running order for each class will be posted on the day.
21. *Class running order as per Schedule.*
22. The show will be held under the rules and regulations of IADSA. All dogs and handlers entered for competition must be fully paid up members of the Irish Agility & Dog Sports Association.

2. I hereby declare that the dog/dogs entered by me as above are not vicious, and are bona-fide my property, and I enter them subject to the rules of the IADSA and the Regulations of the Show which appear in the schedule and which I have read
3. I hereby undertake not to bring within the precincts of the show any dog which has (a) distemper or other communicable disease, unless it has been fully recovered for more than 30 days immediately prior to the show or (b) has been in contact with or in any kennel or establishment containing distemper or any other communicable disease during 30 days immediately prior to the show or (c) has been inoculated with distemper virus or displayed any reaction there from during the 30 days immediately prior to the show or (d) has been in contact during the 30 days immediately prior to the show with any dog which was previously inoculated with distemper within 30 days.
4. IN CONSIDERATION of my entry being accepted, I hereby agree (1) to indemnify the IADSA and/or its Trustees or Officials in respect of any damage or loss from whatsoever source arising, caused by, or to any dogs exhibited by me while in the precincts of the Show and (2) that any decision given concerning me by the IADSA or by any committee thereof in connection with any matter whatsoever arising through or at this Show shall be communicated by the Secretary of the IADSA Ltd. To all whom it may concern, and that any such decision together with a report of the proceedings in the matter may also be published together with my name, address and description.
